CHURCHES TARGET HOMELESSNESS

The Office of Faith-Based and Community Initiatives has partnered with Cornerstone Assistance Network for the public awareness campaign called Season of Service.

Homelessness is the focus of the month of June and congregations are asked to focus on the issue during the last weekend of the month. "Change happens one act of service at a time," said Robin Jones, director of the Office of Faith-Based and Community Initiatives. "It is amazing to think that one adult can literally change the world of at least one child, that we can help them overcome the barriers so they don't repeat the generational cycle of homelessness."

Season of Service continues through August. Hunger will be the campaign's focus in July, followed by the issue of education in August.
